Docility: meekness, obedience



Fickleness: unreliable, likely
to change, capricious

Forsaken: abandoned

Frivolity: silliness, shallowness

Inconstancy: see *fickleness*

Indiscretion: saying something that
should be kept secret



Ingenuous: trusting, sincere, innocent

Malevolence: cruelty, evil,
maliciousness

Misanthropy: not liking other people

Pensiveness: thoughtfulness

Piety: reverence for God or respect
for parents



Remorse: regret

Shaft: a verbal attack, a clever remark

Slighted love: love that is not
valued or ignored

Steadfast: faithful, unchanging

Succour: assistance, help

Temperance: moderation, self-control
